



Start Week on Monday

[Bjorn Sorensen](#) offers these instructions on how to edit [Calendar Snap](#) to make the weekday start on Monday instead of on Sunday.

To start the calendar with Monday I made two extra fields:

◆ Start2	Calculation	Unstored, = DayofWeek(Date_Shown)
◆ RettDag	Calculation	Unstored, = If(Start2="1", "+6", "-1")
